She has served as President of ASLAP and ACLAM, Chair of the NIH Veterinary Subcommittee of the Physician Scientist Workforce Report and AAVMC Research Committee, Member, AVMA Council of Research and Veterinary Virology Councilor for ASV.

She was elected to the National Academy of Sciences in 2019. VandeWoude is currently a University Distinguished Professor and Director of the One Health Institute at Colorado State University.
