

Relational Coordination



Shared goals

Shared knowledge

Mutual respect

Frequent

Timely

Accurate

Problem-solving communication




Relational Facilitation

The intentional use of relational coordination as a framework for facilitating teams



Relational Facilitation Method



Identification

Recognize team roles and responsibilities

Mapping

Plot these roles into a relational map to visually depict the interaction and relationships within a team

Rating

Evaluate relational coordination (RC) within and between roles to understand the working dynamics

Assessment

Deployment of the 7-item RC Survey to assess the larger team network

Goal Setting

Creation of RCrelated SMART goals derived from the survey's results


Evaluation

Utilize the RC survey for assessing the impact of the applied SMART goals

Relational Facilitation Results

Baseline RC Survey Summary	Range
Baseline RC Score	2.87-3.93
Frequent Communication	3.27-4.44
Timely Communication	2.5-3.79
Accurate Communication	2.24–3.84
Problem-solving Communication	3.04-4.12
Shared Goals	2.7–3.99
Shared Knowledge	3.27-4.44
Mutual Respect	3.08 - 4.11

RC Survey Results Comparison



(N = 9 VA medical centers)

 - Team engagement
 - Relationships
 - Communication
