Most training occurs in mentor/mentee pairs; however, some activities will be for mentors or mentees separately. The goal is to help participants build practical, overarching skills for mentoring success.

The CO-Mentor program addresses the following Topics:

- Setting goals
- CV building
- Understanding your preferred communication style with the Communication Preference Questionnaire™ (CPQ)
- Establishing the mentor/mentee relationship
- Writing effective mentor letters
- Giving and receiving effective feedback
- Building an effective mentoring team
- Identifying personal strengths and values
- Professional networking
- Promoting academic persistence
- Understanding and managing the financial aspects of an academic career


