

NRSA mock study section,
Checklist for F submission
All documents should be submitted as a single pdf

Required documents for mock study section:

- Candidate Biosketch
- Sponsor Biosketch
- Co-sponsor Biosketch (if there is a co-sponsor)
- Applicants background and goals for fellowship training including past research, training goals and objectives, activities planned under this award
- Specific aims
- Research Strategy and references
- Sponsor statement- if a co-sponsor, either a letter from co-sponsor or a section in the 'sponsor statement' detailing their role and commitment to the trainee
- If a resubmission, reviews from previous round and response to reviewers
- If letters of support from consultants and collaborators are not yet available, then a list of letters that will be obtained before submission to NIH

Optional for mock study section (but useful):

- Summary
- Narrative
- Respective contributions
- Institutional environment and commitment to training

Not required for mock study section:

- Research facilities
- Equipment
- Selection of sponsor and institution
- Training in the responsible conduct of research
- Vertebrate animals and human subjects
- Resource sharing plan
- Authentication of key biological resources

Note: All of these are required for full submission for NIH.

For those submitting applications for other funding agencies, submit the equivalent docs requested by that agency in their format/order, etc.
