## Biography

George Autobee, BA, Ma, is the President/CEO of World Demographic Research, LLC. He also is a former photo journalist for La Voz Bilingue Newspaper. He is the editor of the book, "The Life and Times of Charles Autobees 1812-1882", co-author of the book "The Hispanic Entrepreneurship Training Program", author of "Marine Grunt to Medic" and co-author of the "Latino Health Disparities Report 2019". He served on the Board of Directors of the United States Hispanic Chamber of Commerce and the Denver Hispanic Chamber of Commerce. He now serves on the Pueblo Latino Foundation Board of Directors. George was founder of Rural Colorado United (PAC) and the Colorado Latino Voter Project Inc.

Mr. Autobee earned an Undergraduate B.A. Degree from Southern Colorado State College as well as a Masters of Arts Degree in Urban Regional Planning from the University of Northern Colorado. He was awarded a Certificate of Completion in Urban Studies, for attending the University of Manchester in England, from the Institute on International Education. He also has attended the University of Denver for studies in Geographical Information Systems (GIS). George was founder of Rural Colorado United (PAC) and the Colorado Latino Voter Project Inc.

His company World Demographic Research LLC., has developed several economic studies on National, State and County Hispanic Business growth reports as well as research on the Hispanic consumer market, for the Hispanic Chambers of Commerce. Other research reports that were developed have been diverse and include health studies such as diabetes impact on the Hispanic community to Hispanic skiers and their economic impact on Colorado.

Mr. Autobee also has produced two 30-minute video documentaries—one was on Hispanic Genealogical Research and the other was the Hispanic Veterans Military Genealogical Research Project "Los Veteranos."

Mr. Autobee was the producer and directed over 100 shows called "The Weekly Issue" and "The Hispanic Chamber Review," a monthly Hispanic Chamber of Commerce television program, with Telemundo Spanish TV.

Mr. Autobee is a Vietnam Veteran 1968-69 and served in the 1st Marine Corps Division. He was wounded twice in combat and awarded Purple Heart with gold star. He reenlisted in the Army Reserves and served with 3rd/87th, 10th Mountain Division 96th ARCOM from 1980-81 and from 1981-89 as Medical Administrative Officer for the 406th Combat Support Hospital, 96th ARCOM.
