





Spectrum of Translational Research



- Mock grant reviews: 3 times a year
 - Applicants and mentors attend
 - Format: reviewers and then panel discusses, followed by Q&A
 - Full written reviews

Research Studio Program

- Expert Panel to provide targeted advice about research project, grant application, idea generation, etc.
- Studio sessions are virtual 90 minutes

Investigator presents brief summary (10-15 minutes)

Focused discussions with experts for 3 or 4 predetermined questions from the investigator (60-70 minutes)


Moderator and panelists provide summarized comments (10-15 minutes)

 2019-2020 participants believed the experience contributed to >\$2M in subsequent grant funding


